

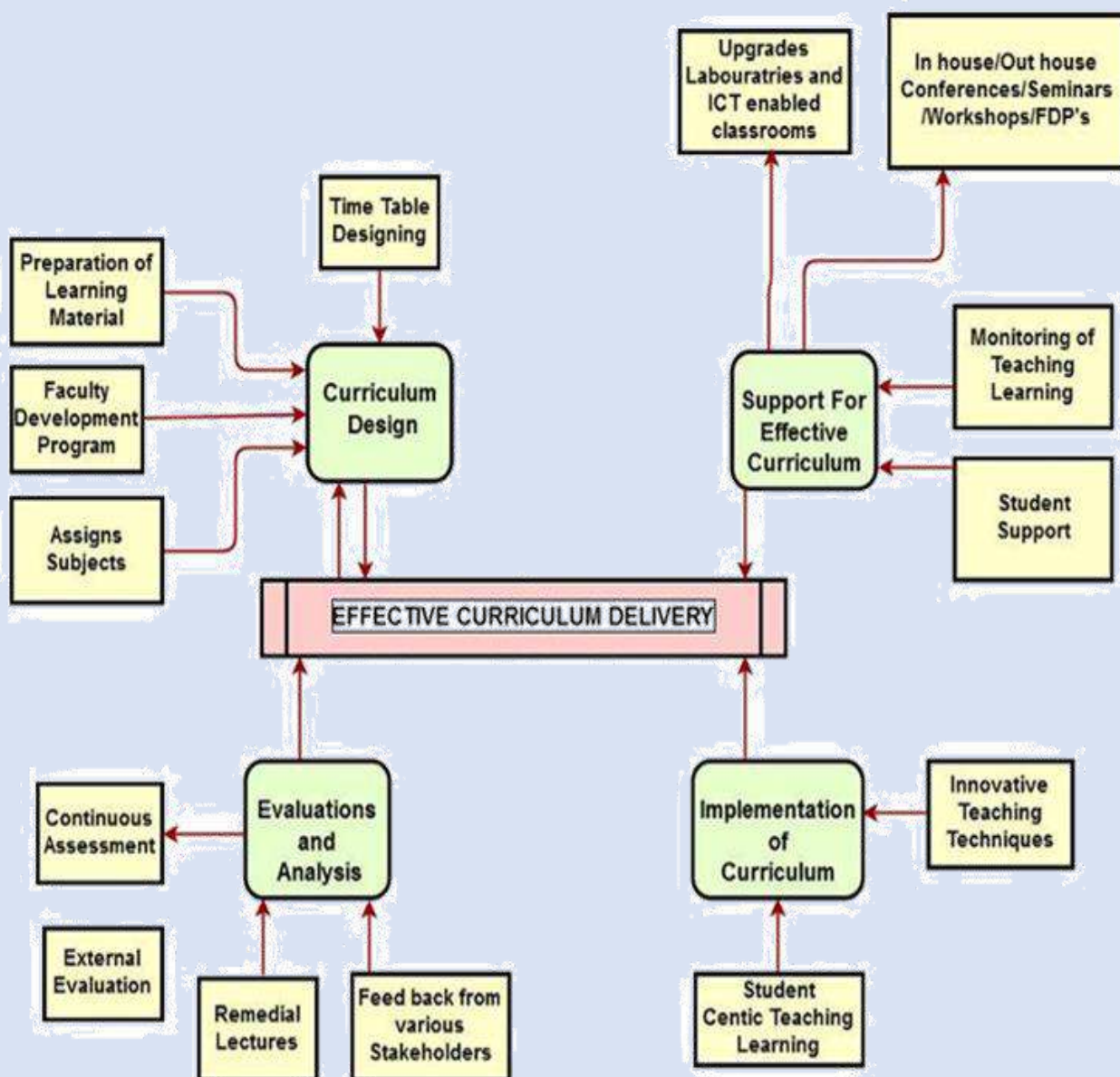

Criterion 1 – Curricular Aspects

1.1.1: The Institution ensures effective curriculum planning and delivery through a well-planned and documented process including Academic calendar and conduct of continuous internal Assessment

• Processing	: The teacher organize the above mentioned activities and guide the students.
