

Summary of the grants received by College in Chikhli from the academic years 2018-19 to 2024-25. The grants were provided by various agencies, predominantly by the Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat (KCG) and the Commissioner of Higher Education Gandhinagar.

Key Observations:

- **Finishing School Grants** were consistently received over multiple years, indicating a strong emphasis on skill development programs.
- **Placement-related Grants**, such as those for job fairs and placement cells, were also received regularly.
- Maintenance grants were received for previous fiscal years, signifying continued support for the institution's infrastructure and operations.
- A significant **PM USHA Grant** of ₹50,000,000 was sanctioned in 2024-25, which stands out as the most substantial grant during the period, potentially earmarked for large-scale developmental or educational initiatives within the institution.

The grants received were aimed at various purposes, including skill development, job placements, infrastructure maintenance, and promoting educational events like the Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav.

The substantial PM USHA grant highlights the institution's ability to secure large funding for its strategic initiatives.
